PROJECT AWARE DAY 2009

In the wake of the 2009 Project Aware Day, an underwater and beach cleanup took place on September 27. Some 60 divers and a 20-person surface crew set out from El Gouna to the well-known Dolphin House dive and snorkeling site. Divers and surface teams were briefed on the use of emergency buoys, ropes, and weights used to pull up the rubbish prior setting off. The three boats lashed together to form a single rubbish disposal unit as pairs of divers filled custom-made linen bags then sent up the emergency buoys for a pickup call while the two Zodiacs raced overhead to lower ropes and pull up the garbage.

After two 1-hour dives, garbage collection was estimated at an impressive 300 kilograms. Debris included fishing lines, blankets, carpets, building material, paint pots, and an array of glass, cups, cutlery, tin cans and sunglasses. On the return journey, cleanup participants were accompanied by a group of dolphins that left them with the romantic impression of having received a well-deserved "Thank You"! The action was initiated and organized by TGI Divers, Orca Divers, Tropical Gangsters Dive Club, Orca Divers, Oototo, Makadi Tours, and the Sultan Bey Hotel's environmental team.

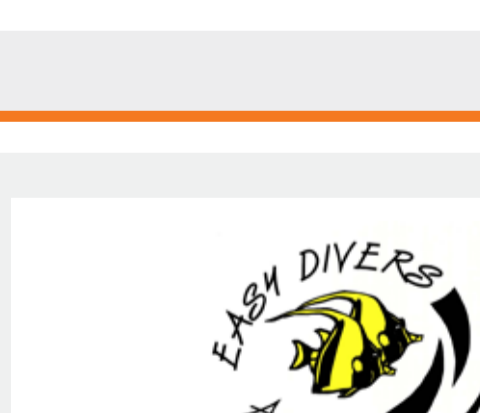


El Gouna's northern beaches were also the site of cleanup action carried out by environmental teams from the Steigenberger Golf Resort, TTC Ocean View, and TTC Rihana in cooperation with Orascom staff. Volunteers spread out along the beaches north of Buzza to clean up more than 2 km of the shoreline. In total, 550 trash bags of rubbish were collected.

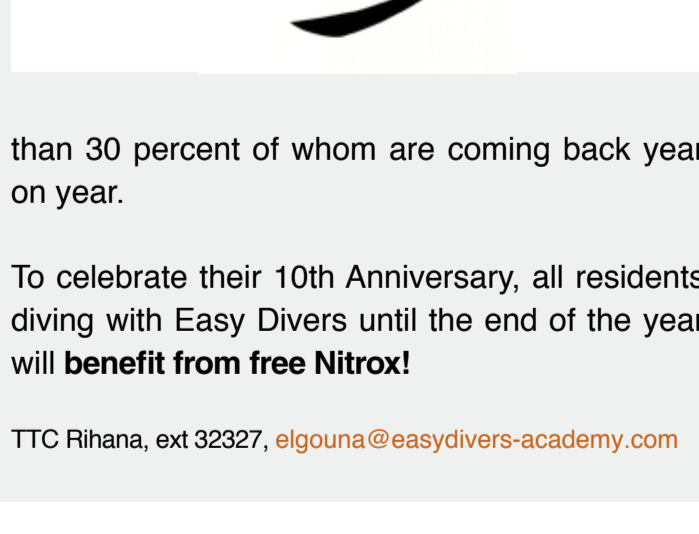

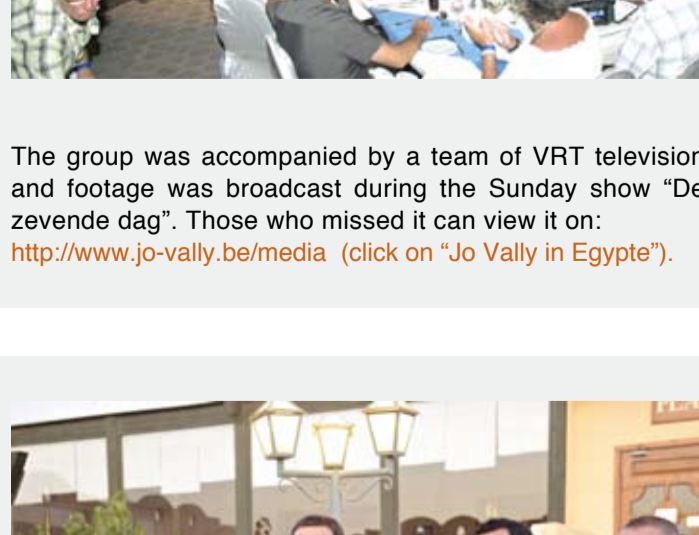
